






### All class placements are tentative for the first week

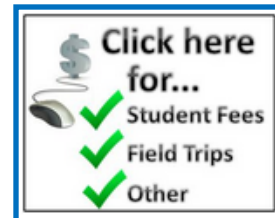
Due to enrollment changes, students will not be placed into their new classes until the 2nd week of school. Students have returned to their last year's class, and are participating in a number of orientation activities this week.
