Happy New Year GATORS! We started term 2 with some wonderful snow to build with! Our



students were challenged to build the tallest snow structure... We had some great snowmen and snow forts! Please remind your children that sleds are not to be brought to school unless directed by classroom teachers for gym class. With 645 students, we are unable to safely supervise sledding during recess breaks. As we head into some colder weather, we have created a cold weather plan so it is very clear for all. Please see below. We are looking forward to a great term ahead. Parent



conferences are scheduled for February 8 & 9 and students will be dismissed at 12:30 on both of those days.

NGE Cold Weather Plan: It is critical that students arrive at school each day prepared for cold weather. Parents should check the local forecast for up-to-date weather information. Students must be dressed appropriately so that they remain safe and comfortable during the following times:

- Outside playtime before and after school
- Lunchtime playtime (30 Minutes)
- Afternoon recess (15 minutes)
- Fire/Evacuation Drills (at all temperatures)
- Bus breakdowns
- Unscheduled and scheduled outside breaks and learning experiences in the community

We do not have a school or district policy for cold weather procedures. However, we follow these guidelines at North Glenmore Elementary:

BELOW FREEZING (-1 Celsius to -15 Celsius): Students are expected to go outside for all play times. Please ensure your child has:

- Warm coat
- Gloves/Mittens
- Head/Ear covering
- Boots
- Neck warmer
- It is recommended that students also bring waterproof snow pants. Remember that students will be outside for the duration of the 30 minute lunch playtime and the 15 minute afternoon recess.

TEMPERATURE REACHES between -16 Celsius to -19 Celsius

If the temperature reaches -16 Celsius to -19 Celsius and the wind is calm, students will go outside for a shortened recess (5 - 15 minutes). If the weather is windy and stormy, students will stay inside.

TEMPERATURE REACHES -20 Celsius or lower

If the temperature reaches -20 Celsius, students will stay inside during lunch and recess.


