Any parents wishing to participate in the Hot Lunch Program will need to create a new account and register your children. Instructions are provided below.

We are only offering the Fun Hot Lunch program for grades 1 to 6. Parents with kindergarten children will unfortunately not be able to participate, but it is something to look forward to for next year.

Registration will open Monday September 8. You may log in then and order for the Fall Session.

Ordering will be closed Friday October 3. All orders must be paid in full by this date. Unfortunately if there are any outstanding balances past this date, please know that your child's hot lunches will not be ordered until that balance is paid in full.

The first Hot Lunch will be on October 15th.

Registration

Here's how to get started on the website:

- **Go to nge.hotlunches.net**
- **Click on "Click Here to Register"**
- **Enter Access Code NGHL**
- **Complete the rest of the registration form (Including your email address to ensure you receive reminder emails about hot lunch order deadlines, and your child's hot lunch order for the upcoming week)**
- **Click the "Register Now" button at the bottom**
- **Follow the instructions to add each child in your family that is attending North Glenmore Elementary**
- **Once your child(ren) are registered, click on "Orders"**
- **Proceed to order hot lunch and fundraising programs**

PayPal:

We only accept hot lunch and fundraising order payments through PayPal (www.paypal.com) We cannot accept Cheque or cash payments at this time. You can either pay with a credit card as a PayPal guest or set up a PayPal account.

The hot lunch online order system requires a small amount of setup time at the beginning as you must register each child you have attending our school prior to ordering. Once the initial set up process is complete, your hot lunch and fundraising orders for the remainder of the year should be quick and simple.

Please Note:

If your child will be away on a hot lunch day, please email us by 9:00am the day of to arrange for an alternate pickup, or we can leave it at the front office for pick up later in that day. If we do not hear from you, we will take that to mean you would like it donated to another child.
