KISS & DROP CHANGES COMING

In collaboration with the City of Kelowna Clean Air & Safe Routes to School Initiative, North Glenmore will be introducing some changes to our Kiss & Drop for the 2022/2023 academic year. We hope these changes will be in place for September. Some of the changes include:

- Our current Kiss and drop area will move from the top loop to bottom loop
- There will be NO Left turn exiting on to Snowsell from Kiss and drop between 8:15 8:45 AM
- There will be NO pick up in parking lot at end of day parents will have to park and walk at the end of the day
- There will be more parking on the street for parents (as we create more staff parking stalls on upper loop)
- school busses will drop kids in the MORNING in the new designated bus only area on Snowsell

The preferred option when dropping off or picking up your children is to park away from the site and take a short walk to the gates.

If you must park near to the school and space is limited, please follow the rules.

- Do NOT park within 5 meters of driveways.
- Do NOT park across dropped curbs or driveways.
- Do NOT double park.
- Do NOT park on footpaths.
- Do NOT stop to drop kids off in the center of the road.
- Always abide by the restriction sign
- only park in permitted areas.
- PLEASE park safely and be considerate of children, parents and residents by not causing an obstruction.
